Calling for Expressions of Interest for Consultancy Services for Civil Engineer (Hydrology) (4), Project Engineers (8), Project Officers (6), Draughtsmen (27), Hydrological Assistants (3) and Technical Assistants (4)

The Climate Resilience Multi-Phase Programmatic Approach (CResMPA) is funded by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (The World Bank) and executed by the Ministry of Irrigation. The Project Coordinating Unit (PCU) of the CResMPA intends to apply part of the proceeds to obtain consultancy services from qualified and experienced individual consultants for effective and efficient implementation of the project to realize the project development objectives. The PCU of the CResMPA on behalf of the Project Consultants Procurement Committee – (PCPC), is now inviting qualified individual consultants to submit interest in providing expert services under the following specialized subject areas by providing a detailed resume indicating the justification to undertake the activities related to the subject area specified under each consultancy position mentioned below and the scope of work described for each position that can be downloaded from the **www.irrigationmin.gov.lk** under public notices.

The individual consultants are required to provide information on qualifications, previous experience related to the position, and justification to show dedication to perform the result-oriented services through teamwork, and excellent interpersonal skills for delivering the results in the relevant subject area specified below and in the scope of work. The minimum qualification and experience required for each position and workplace are given below :

- **01. Civil Engineer Hydrology (4 positions)** B Sc. in Civil Engineering or Environmental Engineering or related field specializing in hydrology as a major subject area with at least 3 years of experience in hydrology-related or disaster management experience is required. The workplace is the Hydrological and Disaster Management Division of the Irrigation Department, Head Office.
- **02. Project Engineer (8 positions)** B Sc in Civil Engineering/Mechanical Engineering/Earth Resource Engineering with at least 3 years of experience in the construction industry. Preference will be given to consultants having experience in irrigation rehabilitation works. The workplace is the PCU of CResMPA and the Head Office of the Irrigation Department.
- **03. Project Officer (6 positions)** Basic degree in Agriculture or Science or Management or Economics or disaster management or Rural development with at least 2 years of experience in foreign-funded projects or development programs implemented by public, private, and international Non-governmental Organizations. The workplace is PCU of CResMPA.
- **04. Draughtsman (27 positions)** Should have a minimum NVQ 5 level qualification with 3 years experience in preparation of drawings, BOQ and estimates, checking estimates, maintaining work schedules for procurement plans, checking material cards (Labour, material and machinery), preparation and checking comparative estimates and revised estimates, checking Interim Payment certificates (IPC) and measurement book and checking as-built drawings for payment recommendation. The workplace is DI ranges, Construction and Development Divisions of the Irrigation Department and PCT.

05. Hydrological Assistants (3 positions) -

S/he should pass GCE AL in 3 subjects in the math stream at least 3 subjects and should have 3 years of experience in collecting, processing and reporting hydrological measurements including day-to-day river flow data and reservoir water levels, hydrological survey data and GPS survey data for flood forecasting and early warnings. Experience in computer applications for data analysis and processing using MS Office package and hydrological modeling software packages and proven experience in GIS applications for flood modeling is an added qualification. The workplace is the Hydrological and Disaster Management Division of the Irrigation Department.

06. Project Technical Assistants (4 positions)

Should have completed Quantity Survey theory and practical part of National Diploma in Quantity Survey or NVQ level 05 qualifications similar to National Diploma in Quantity Survey and a minimum of 6 months experience in checking estimates, part payment bills and preparation of progress report and database management for monitoring contract packages.

Other requirements for all the above positions :

- Highly motivated, committed, and prepared to travel extensively in the project-implementing districts
- Working knowledge of spoken and written English and ability to work independently using the Microsoft Office Packages
- The ability to work in other local languages would also be considered as an added qualification.
- The high degree of independence, flexibility, and ability to meet strict deadlines and targets.
